

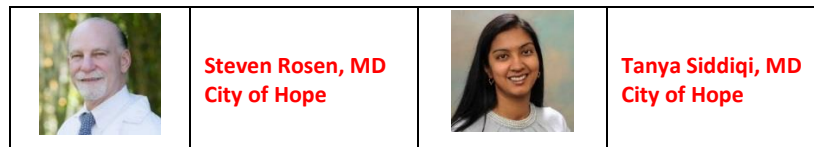


POST-ASH CLL PATIENT AND CAREGIVER EDUCATIONAL FORUM
