WHAT CLL/SLL PATIENTS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT MEDICARE CHANGES

2022

- Medicare Part D Drug Rebates

2023

- CLL/SLL patients with Diabetes will not pay more than \$35 for a month's supply of insulin
- ACIP recommended vaccines, including the shingles vaccine will be available at no cost to patients on Medicare Part D

2024

- Average premium increase for most Part D plans will be capped at 6%
- Expanded Low-Income Subsidy Program takes effect

2025

- CLL/SLL patients with Medicare Part D won't pay more than \$2,000 out-of-pocket for prescription drugs and will have a monthly payment plan option
- Government reinsurance in the catastrophic phase of Part D will decrease from 80% to 20% for most brand-name drugs, biologicals, and biosimilars and will decrease from 80% to 40% for generics.
